The event, which will continue till November 17, was inaugurated by the guest of honor, Dr Pike See Universiti Putra Malaysia. He emphasised on the importance of translational research in the field on neuroscience. Translational neuroscience applies findings from fundamental laboratory research relating to brain structure and function to development of new therapies for neurodegenerative, neuropsychiatric and neurodevelopmental diseases.

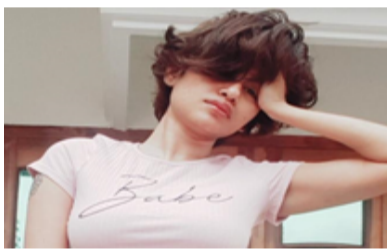

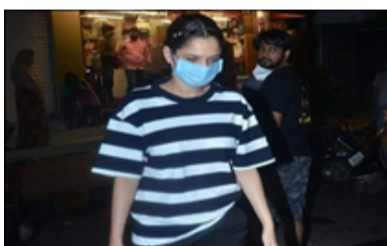

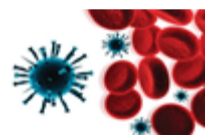
