To provide resources for Asia/Pacific researchers and those interested in Asia/Pacific neuroscience, APRC develops and proposes the annual budget for IBRO's Asia/Pacific activities. APRC also works closely with the Federation of Asian-Oceanian Neuroscience Societies (FAONS), the IBRO Asia/Pacific member societies and other Asia/Pacific and global scientific networks to increase brain research and awareness in the region.
