

Dr. Ai-Huey Tan (MD, PhD, FRCP Edin) is an Associate Professor and Consultant Neurologist/Movement Disorder Specialist at the University of Malaya. She was the former President of the Malaysian Society of Neurosciences, and Treasurer of the ASEAN Neurological Association. Dr Tan serves on several committees in the International Parkinson's and Movement Disorder Society (MDS) including being the Chair of the MDS Web-based Learning Subcommittee, Vice Chair of the MDS Communications Oversight Committee and Executive Committee Member of the MDS-Asian and Oceanian Section. She is also actively involved in the MDS Evidence-based Task Forces for the treatment of motor and non-motor symptoms in PD. Dr Tan's research areas are in Parkinson's Disease and Movement Disorders, with a particular interest in exploring the role of gut infections and gut microbiota in neurodegenerative diseases. Other research scopes include genetics, inflammation and geriatric aspects of parkinsonian disorders, and the characterization of rare/orphan neurological diseases.
